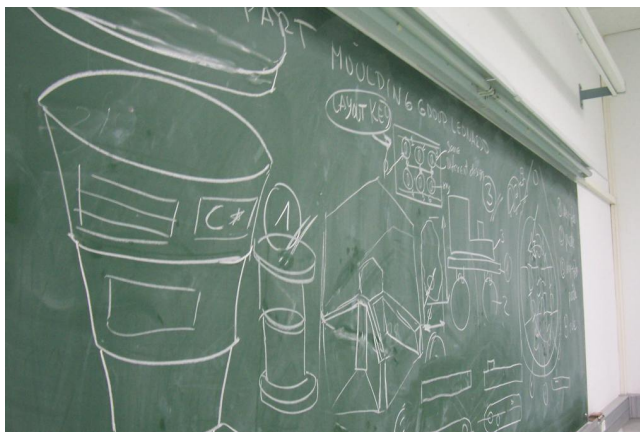
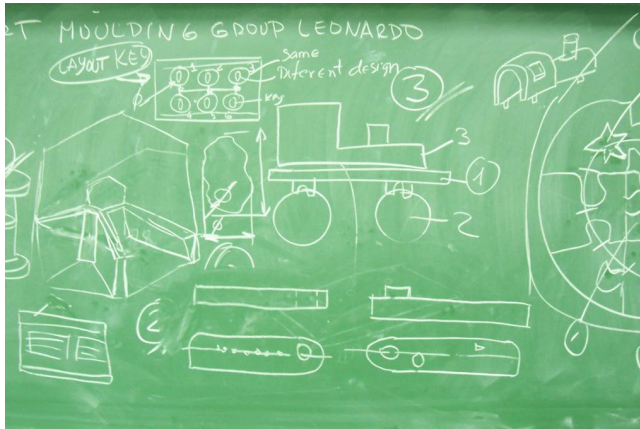
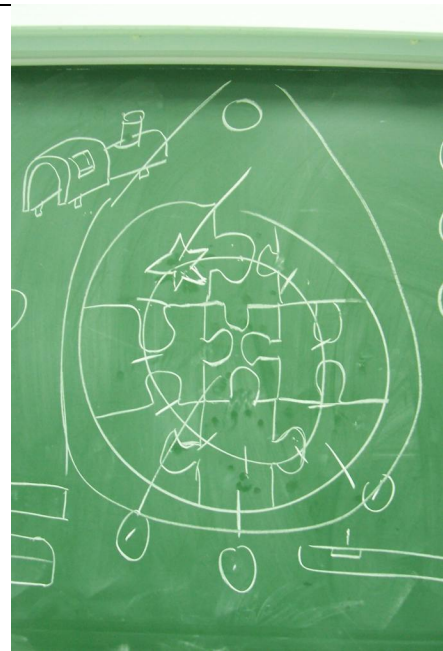

Results / Decisions / Tasks / Points of importance

1. Heinz Wildgrube as the representative of the coordinating school welcomes all the present partners and says thank you to Jaume Coll, representative of Salesians de Sarrià for the hospitality and good organization of the meeting.
2. All partners introduce themselves to the group and give a short report of their home schools and daily work with the students.
3. Heinz Wildgrube takes over by giving a short flashback. On the one hand, the objectives of the project are again visualized and on the other hand, the application as it has been submitted to the European Commission are discussed and made clear again to all the participants. Expectations can clearly be seen when having a closer look at the rating, the application got from the German National Agency. They rated this project with maximum credits. As the Maltesian school could not receive any financial support for this project, it will not participate.
4. Decision on the kind and form of the injection mould product is discussed. Therefore, within this LdV project, different ideas are introduced as follows:
 - Cenfim, Portugal:
a pencil/pen “container” in hexagonal form and flexible with six faces (representing the six partners) and with a puzzle on the six containers
 - Mehmet Rustu Uzel Endustri Meslek Lisesi, Turkey:
an “extendible” conical cup with six flexible sections (representing the six partners), used for travel and car.
 - Salesians de Sarrià, Spain:
a key fob with a logo on it, very easy to produce
 - BBS TGHS from Germany :
(1) a puzzle in circular shape, may be useable as a mat to put hot pots on,
(2) a model train like the one from Aarburg company, seen at Expoquimia fair in Barcelona or
(3) a whistle similar to the aluminum model manufactured by the Heidenhain company.
 - HTL St. Pölten from Fulpmes, Austria:
a graduated compass/ruler for technical measuring



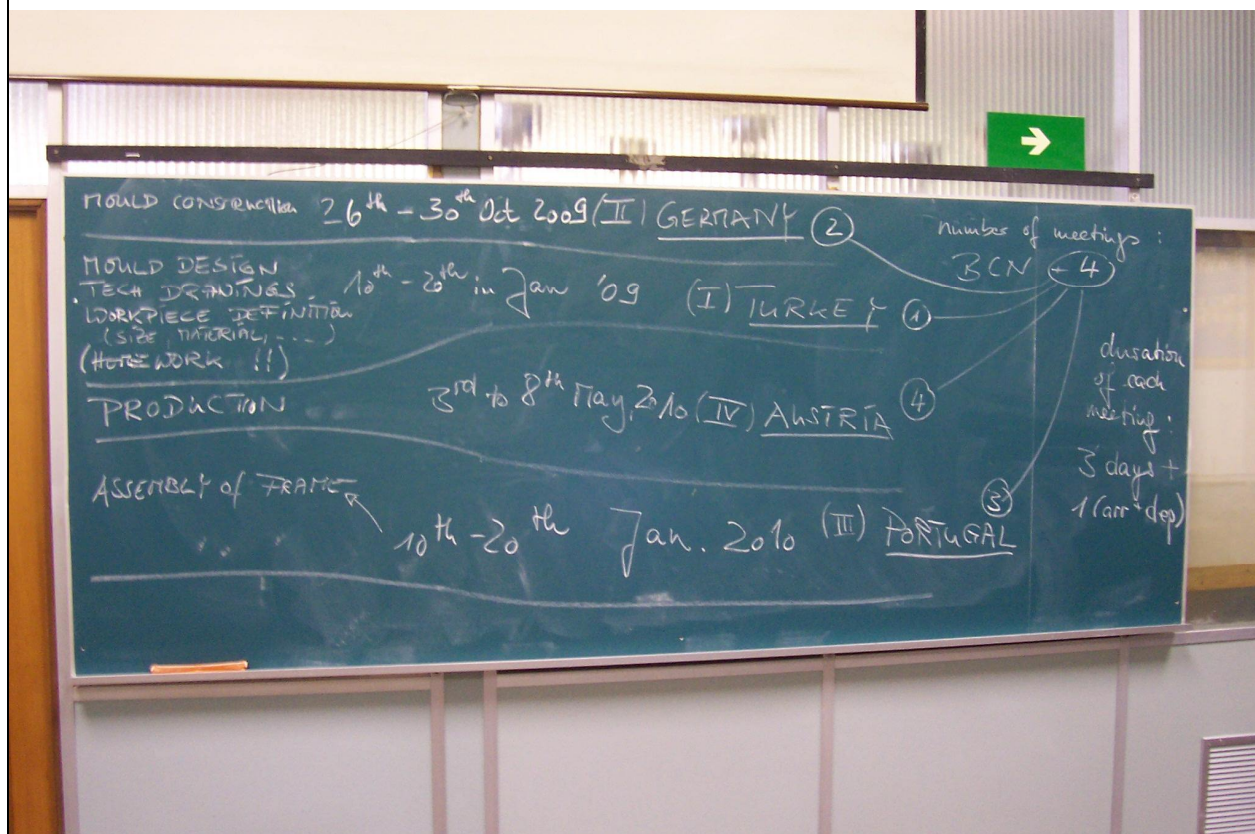
5. Result of the discussion:

a key fob (Spain) and a puzzle (Germany) will be produced in a combined unit and all partners have to be involved in the design, programming and production of the mould and the product itself.

7. Decisions on the number of meetings and the schedule of the project are taken. Not only the places, but also the times for the different meetings need to be discussed and fixed in order to offer planning reliability:
- **2nd meeting: between 10th and 20th January, 2009, Turkey:**
design and shape of the product - Homework: for all participants: Prepare a presentation of your ideas drawings or a prototype in aluminium may be shown.
 - **3rd meeting: 26th to 30th October, 2009, Bad Kreuznach, Germany**
Presentation of mould design and planning of production procedure;
 - **4th meeting: between 10th and 20th January, 2010, Portugal:**
Presentation of structure and electrodes, further planning
 - **Final meeting: 3rd week of May, 2010, Austria:**
Presentation of the injected final product, strategy of dissemination of the product will have to be defined.



8. The duration of each meeting should be four days. Three days are necessary for hard working on the project tasks and participating at cultural activities and one day for arrival and departure.
9. As no further questions or problems are mentioned, the meeting ends. Heinz Wildgrube thanks all partners for the successful cooperation starting now in Barcelona and closes the meeting in giving presents to our hosts and in wishing a journey back home without any problems.
