Protocol from 5th May till 9th May 2010

Wednesday, 5th May 2010:

We arrived at 5pm in our Hotel Eschenhof. We met at 7 pm in the hotel restaurant and were welcomed by Harald Falschunger. After an introduction to the program of the following days by the headmaster of the Austrian school, we had dinner with all European project members.

Thursday, 6th May 2010:

First day at HTL Fulpmes:

At 9: 00 am we met at the Technical College of Fulpmes to get some information about the history and technological advances within the project. After that we had a guided tour through the whole school. In the afternoon we went to the workshop to assemble the mould. After that we started the successful production of our first cube. As shown in the pictures, you can see the moulding machinery in progress as well as the mould itself.



Friday, 7th May 2010:

On Friday morning we manufactured hundreds of pieces. Then we cut off the flashes and sorted the cube pieces in different boxes. During that, the Austrian school organized a celebration to present the EU-project to the local press, politicians and the other students.

After lunch we visited the “Stubai”- company. There we had a guided tour where we saw the manufacturing of different forged parts. We got a very good impression and insight into this famous company.



Saturday, 8th May 2010:

Travel to Innsbruck:

After a nice evening in Fulpmes, we met at the train station of Fulpmes in order to take the train to Innsbruck, the capital of Tyrol, which was reached after an one hour trip.



In Innsbruck we had a guided tour. The nice cathedral and the world famous „Goldene Dachel“ were the highlights. After the guided tour we had free time for having lunch and shopping. The next stop was the „Nordkettenbahn“ station and 20 minutes later we got to a level above sea of about 1905 meters. This mountain is known as “Innsbrucker Nordkette”.
